PET bottles for soft drinks. It is relatively safe. You should not refill PET bottles as the risk of additives leakage increase.

plastic containers and pipes. It is considered safe and is easy to recycle.

sewage pipes and synthetic window frames. It is to be avoided. In the manufacturing process the toxic dioxin is released and softeners are often added.

soft plastics such as cling film, plastic drycleaner covers, carry bags. It is considered safe.

plastic furniture, jerry cans, car parts, bottle tops. It is considered safe.

disposable cups, meat trays, packaging for electronics. It is to be avoided because of possible leakage of styrene.

Code 7 is a miscellaneous category that nobody can do anything with.
